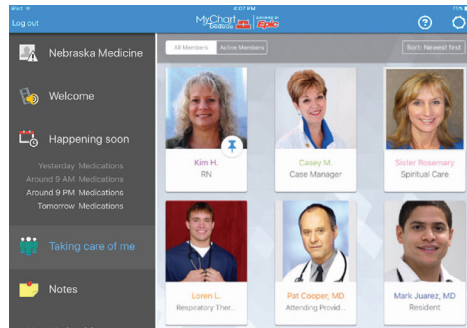
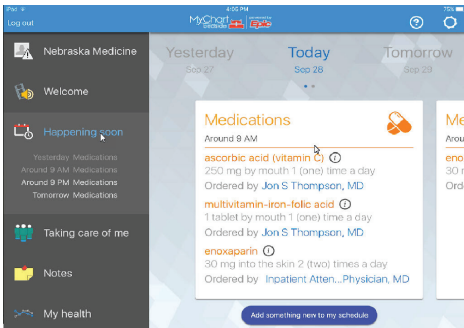
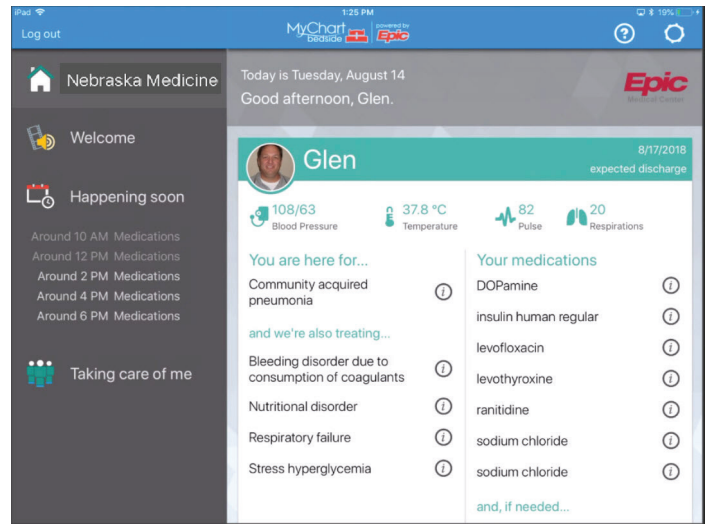


One Chart | Patient Bedside

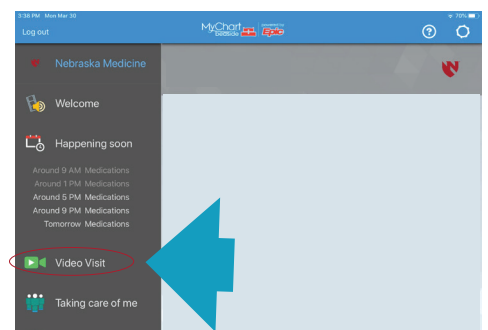
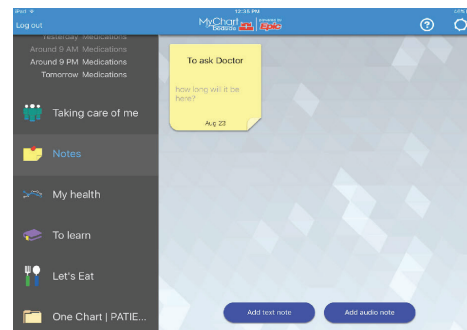
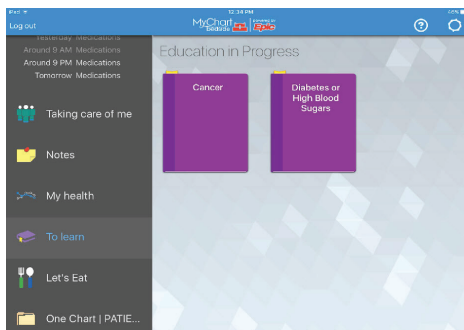
Your Care, Education and Health Information



Review past and upcoming events. You can also add events like a visit from a family member.

See photos and some information about who is taking care of you.

View up-to-date information during your hospital stay.



Learn about your care. You will find education materials assigned to you about your diagnosis, medicines, procedures and lab results. You and your family will be able to read and watch education videos at your own pace.

Take notes or record audio notes to refer to later.

Have a video visit with your care team.

What is One Chart | Patient Bedside?



One Chart | Patient Bedside allows you to view most of your health information during your hospital stay.

What is One Chart | Patient?



One Chart | Patient is a secure, online web portal that can be used at home after you are discharged.

Ask your care team about the added convenience and features available in the portal such as paying bills, asking your doctor health questions and direct scheduling.

What is the Nebraska Medicine app?



The Nebraska Medicine app is a mobile app that allows you to access everything in the One Chart | Patient portal on the go.

Do I need my own tablet to use the MyChart Bedside app?

Not necessarily. A Nebraska Medicine tablet will be provided to you during your hospital stay. MyChart Bedside is already loaded onto the tablet with other apps that can be used for entertainment. However, if you have your own personal tablet, you can download the Nebraska Medicine app from the Apple App Store on your Apple device or from the Google Play Store on your Android device.

Are other apps allowed on the hospital-provided tablet?

No. Only the apps that are preloaded on the tablet provided to you can be used.

Can I look at my email or log in to my personal apps on the hospital-provided tablet?

No. You should not purchase products or provide personal information including email addresses, user names, and passwords when using this device. Even though we use a process for clearing the data on the tablet before another patient is given the same tablet, we do not recommend that you enter personal logins or account information on this device.

Can my family member look at my personal health information on a tablet?

Yes. You can authorize another family member access to your information on One Chart | Patient portal and the Nebraska Medicine mobile app. For more details, discuss this with your nurse.

How and when are my test results displayed?

Test results are released at different intervals while you are in the hospital. At discharge, all finalized results will be released to your One Chart | Patient account.
