"Life is stressful. We all say and do things we regret when things get tough. Respite helps me be a much better mom. It is a wonderful, wonderful thing."



WHAT IS RESPITE?

Respite allows the family caregiver an opportunity to have time to do what is needed to take care of themselves.

WHO IS A CAREGIVER?

A family caregiver is a person who cares for someone who has a longterm/lifelong physical or psychological challenge. If your loved one cannot be left alone due to their disability, we can help.

RESPITE ALLOWS THE FAMILY CAREGIVER TO:

- Go to the grocery store
- Visit the doctor
- Have lunch with a friend
- Attend a church or school function
- Take a nap
- Go out of town for a few days
- Relax, knowing the person you take care of is not alone!

WHAT IS THE NEBRASKA **RESPITE NETWORK?**

The Nebraska Respite Network consists of six sites statewide with coordinators who help families identify respite resources and match families to respite providers.



WHO PROVIDES RESPITE?

Respite can occur in many different ways and places depending on the needs of the caregiver and the person they are caring for.

Respite providers can be paid or volunteers.

Respite providers can be a networkapproved provider or a neighbor, friend, or relative.

Long term care facilities, adult day care, and child care facilities can provide respite.

Having your loved one attend a camp can provide a period of respite.

Respite is based on your individual needs and what is available in your area.

FIND RESPITE RESOURCES:
