Health Care Team

Surgical Oncologist

A cancer surgeon specializing in the care of patients with pancreatic cancer.

- Will evaluate your tests, x-rays, and scans
- If feasible, will perform surgery to remove your tumor safely
- Will direct any additional procedures or surgeries that may be required

Medical Oncologist

A cancer doctor specializing in the care of patients with pancreatic cancer.

- Will evaluate your tests, x-rays, and scans
- If safe and feasible, will recommend medicines to destroy cancer cells and prevent them from recurring (chemotherapy and systemic treatments)
- Will manage the side effects caused by cancer treatments

Radiation Oncologist

A cancer doctor specialized in the treatment of cancer with radiation.

- Will evaluate your tests, x-rays, and scans
- If indicated, will direct radiation therapy treatment to destroy cancer cells
- Will manage the side effects caused by the radiation therapy treatments

Gastroenterologist

A doctor specializing in care of the gastrointestinal tract.

- Will perform procedures to assist in the diagnosis of pancreatic cancer
- Can perform procedures to relieve blockages and improve symptoms

Radiologist

A doctor specialized in reading x-rays and other scans. These tests are used in the diagnosis and treatment of many diseases, including pancreatic cancer.

- Will evaluate ultrasound, CT scan, and MRI
- · Will find and measure tumors that appear in your scans to help in making treatment decisions

Pathologist

A doctor specialized in the examination of tissue samples under the microscope. These results will help the team determine the diagnosis, choose the best treatment, and assess treatment response.

Palliative Care Specialist

A medical provider specialized in the care of patients with serious illness.

- · Will recommend therapies to manage symptoms of disease and side effects of treatment
- Will focus on relieving physical and emotional distress and improving quality of life

Genetic Counselor

A counselor specialized in identifying risk factors for diseases caused by inherited genes.

• Will evaluate the need for special testing and counsel you on test results

Case Manager

A nurse or other medical professional who will help to coordinate your care and assist with any problems during your treatment and recovery.

• Will work with you and your team to coordinate treatments, schedule appointments, tests and procedures, and facilitate communication between you and the health care team

Dietitian

A counselor specialized in nutrition to help you deal with complex nutritional problems during your treatment and healing.

- Available before, during, and after your treatments. Can advise how to eat during treatment and how to deal with symptoms such as nausea
- Will help you to adjust eating after surgery
