

STAT Intubation/CPR for patient w/ UNKNOWN COVID Status – NonCOVID-INPATIENT Departments



Floor Lead Distributes N-95, Gown, Gloves & Goggles to Team Members Entering the Room

Code Cart & PPE Kit Remain in Hallway

Floor Lead limits # of Team Members in Room

Team provides care to patient

COVID Testing Indicated? **

Yes

Team follows transfer guidelines and moves patient to appropriate location for care

No

Staff in the room post procedure continue to wear PPE for 60min or until exiting the room with removal of PPE per protocol

Door is closed and room is left empty x 60 minutes after transfer to allow for air exchange

Patient door remains closed x 60min following procedure with minimal opening to allow the exit of staff

Continue Patient Care using COVID Precautions

Continue Patient Care using Standard Precautions

- PPE Kits:
- N 95 Mask- (10) 1870 plus, (2)1860 small, (2) 1860
 - Yellow Gowns (10)
 - Goggles (10)
 - Brown Bags (10)
 - Sharpie Marker (2)

Recommended Staff in room for CPR (Less staff indicated for STAT Intubation)

- Three providers:
 - Intubation
 - Assist with Med Delivery/Compression/Intubation
 - Team Lead
- Three RN's
 - Medication Administration
 - Chest Compressions
 - Running Defibrillator (dedicated ICU Lead)
- One Respiratory Therapist
 - Assist provider w/ intubation
 - Assist w/ compressions

Ad Hoc – Stationed Outside of the Room & Ready to don PPE and go in room if needed:

- Pharmacy
- Nurse for Documentation & Monitoring (Communicate in room via Voalte to landline outside the room)
- Respiratory Therapist
- Phlebotomy

****NOT All instances of a Code/ STAT Intubation require testing for COVID-19. The Need to test will be determined based on the clinical scenario of the patient**
