



How to Document Your Flu Status from Off Network

1. In order to remote in to the network after Sept. 30, 2019, you need to install and enroll in Intelligent Hub and Duo. More information is available here: <https://info.unmc.edu/it/services/mdm/index.html>. You may also contact IT Helps at 402.559.7700.
2. If you have already installed Intelligent Hub and Duo, go to <https://appstore.nebraskamed.com>
3. Enter your network user name and click Next:




